Quartermaster Report: Submitted by Rick. Attached to original minutes. Highlighted points:

The new equipment order sheet has been circulated to all scouters and as agreed in June, Rick will have gear available for pickup at the seacan or his house (with one weeks notice). Rick has requested authority to purchase more canning pots and has priced a set out at Canadian Tire but will wait until they come up on sale (\$40 approximately). Lloyd has offered to help out with any hinge work i.e. propane cage repair and Greg further offered to pickup the empty cage and take it to his workplace for welding.
